Interactive rubrics cannot be copied from one course to another using the copy function. In order to move a rubric from one course to another, you must export a ZIP file from the **SOURCE** and import to the **DESTINATION** course. Below are the steps on how to export a rubric.

EXPORTING A RUBRIC

1. First, navigate to the **COURSE NAVIGATION** area of your course, located on the left-hand side of your page, and click **COURSE TOOLS.**



2. Next, scroll to and select **RUBRICS**.



3. Click the RADIO BUTTON next to the RUBRIC you wish to EXPORT and select EXPORT.

4. On the next page, choose where you would like the **ZIP FILE** to download. Then, **SUBMIT.**

5. Next, click DOWNLOAD. Then, OK.





NOTES: A ZIP FILE WILL AUTOMATICALLY (DEPENDING ON SETTINGS) DOWNLOAD TO YOUR COMPUTER.

IMPORTING A RUBRIC

Navigate to the **DESTINATION COURSE** you wish to **IMPORT** the **ZIP FILE** just downloaded. Once inside the course, repeat steps 1 and 2 above.

1. Once you have completed steps 1 and 2. Click on IMPORT RUBRIC.



2. Click BROWSE LOCAL FILES to find the ZIP FILE saved. Then, click SUBMIT.

ASSOCIATING RUBRIC TO ASSESSMENT

Once the **RUBRIC** is added to the Tools area, you will then have to associate it to the assessment. Follow the below steps on how to associate a **RUBRIC** to a **DISCUSSION BOARD**.



NOTES: THESE STEPS WILL BE THE SAME WHEN ASSOCIATING A RUBRIC TO AN ASSIGNMENT AND TEST.

1. Navigate to the **DISCUSSION BOARD** you wish to associate the **RUBRIC** to. Click the dropdown menu to the right and click **EDIT**.



2. Scroll to ASSOCIATED RUBRICS. Hover over ADD RUBRIC and click SELECT RUBRIC.



3. A new window will appear. Click the **RADIO BUTTON** next to the **RUBRIC** you will use and click **SUBMIT.**
